

English

Our new core text is 'Incredible You', a humorous and light-hearted rhyming poem about why it is great to be exactly who we are. We will be writing our own poems and exploring aspect of self-identity, before writing our own narrative stories based on the book.

Science

In term 6, Year 2 will be learning about animals and their offspring. They will identify that animals have young and that offspring grow into adult animals. They will compare different animal life cycles and begin to recognise similarities and differences between offspring and their parents.

History

We will be finding all about space exploration, with a focus on two inspiring explorers: Neil Armstrong and Mae Jemison. We will use a range of sources to find out more, and develop our historical sequencing skills. We will discuss how their achievements and legacy are remembered and celebrated.

Computing

This half term, Year 2 will be learning about Programming B – Programming Quizzes. The children will create and debug simple programs, designing their own quizzes using basic coding instructions. They will develop their understanding of algorithms, sequencing, and how programs follow clear steps to achieve specific outcomes.



Year 2 Term 6

Celebration: How should we celebrate our own and others' achievements?

Religious Education

This half term, Year 2 will explore the question: Why do Christians believe God gave Jesus to the world? The children will learn about key Christian beliefs, the Christmas story, and the idea of Jesus as a gift to the world. They will begin to understand why Jesus is important to Christians and reflect on meanings of giving, kindness and love.

Music

This half term, Year 2 will be exploring Preludes, focusing on singing and performing summer songs. They will develop their vocal skills, rhythm and awareness of pitch, including learning the song "Tanczmy Labada". They will also watch traditional Polish dances, responding to the music through movement and discussion, and build confidence in singing and performing together.

Maths

This term, Year 2 will focus on time and statistics. They will learn to tell and write the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past, quarter to and 5-minute intervals, as well as understanding minutes in an hour and hours in a day. They will also collect, organise and interpret data using tally charts, tables, block diagrams and pictograms, developing their reasoning and problem-solving skills.

PSHE

In term 6, Year 2 will be learning about Changing Me. They will explore how they have changed as they grow, discuss the changes that happen as people get older, and learn about growing up in a positive and age-appropriate way. They will also reflect on their achievements and celebrate how they have developed this year.

Art

Our focus will be on portraits! We will look at a range of artists and media, and build up our skills to create our own self-portraits, celebrating our wonderful personalities and achievements.

PE

In preparation for sports day, we will develop our sprinting, jumping and throwing skills. We will also work on our striking and fielding skills and learn how to follow the rules of a game.
