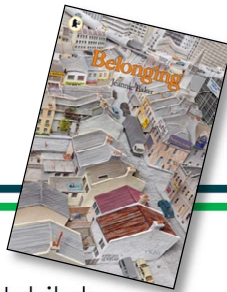


English

Science

Our topic is Living Things and their Habitats.

This term, we're focusing on the objectives:

- Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants.
- Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats.

Geography

We're learning about our city – Bristol! We will ...

- Identify key human and physical features of Bristol.
- Use simple fieldwork and observational skills in the local environment.

Computing

We will explore IT around school and beyond by recognising their common uses. We will consider why some information online isn't true or real.

Community: How can we care for people in our city?

Religious Education

We're exploring the question, 'Is it possible to be kind to everyone all of the time'? through the lens of Christianity.

- Explore stories about special people (Jesus).
- Explore how families, friends, and role models (inc. Jesus) influence how people behave.
- Evaluating our own and others' values in order to make informed, rational and imaginative choices.

Maths

We'll be exploring **place value** and we'll begin **addition and subtraction**.

PSHE

We'll be exploring what it means to 'be in my world' with themes such as hopes and fears; rights and responsibilities; reward and consequence; our class learning charter.

Art

We're focusing on collage inspired by our core text. We will be ...

Combining rubbings, different textures and materials to create collages.

Unpicking Jeannie Baker's approach to art.

Exploring colour theory include complementary colours.

PE

We are exploring dance with a focus on using counts and mirroring movements to create patterns.

Outdoors, we're focusing on team games and the skills of dribbling, throwing and catching.

Music

We're revisiting our recorder skills and learning some harvest themed songs! We're also going to compose some of our own call and response songs using simple patterns.
