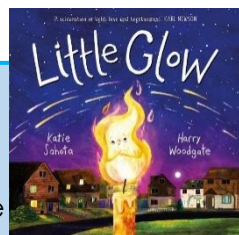

Year 3 Topic: Celebration: Festivals

Art

In our exciting art project, we will explore the rich tapestry of celebrations and festivals from around the world. Using a variety of art supplies and techniques, we will create vibrant pieces that reflect the joy and significance of these unique cultural events (eg. Holi, Diwali and Eid)

PSHE

The children will learn about a selection of relationships including: family roles and responsibilities, friendships, keeping ourself safe online, and being a global citizen. It equips them with skills to navigate social situations, understand boundaries, and build healthy relationships with peers and adults.

RE

The children will learn about a selection of different deities and what they demonstrate about Brahman. Many Sanatanis might choose to worship him in one of his different appearances. These are called Deities. It is important throughout this enquiry to consistently reinforce that all deities are Brahman in different forms, not individual gods.

Computing

Year 3 will be looking at programming this term. We will be writing algorithms and programs that use a range of events to trigger sequences of actions.

Science – Light

This term, we will be learning about light. We will explore different sources of light, such as the sun and artificial lights. In our lessons, we will investigate how we see objects and how shadows are formed. We will carry out exciting experiments to discover how light travels and interacts with various materials. By the end of this term, Year 3 will have a deeper understanding of light and its importance in our everyday lives.
